

PIANIST TRAINING AND RESPONSABILITIES

During their residence, pianists in the Atelier lyrique will gain crucial professional experience while mastering their skills as repetiteurs and coaches. Pianists are expected to prepare operatic scores for rehearsals with Opéra de Montréal and Atelier lyrique productions while taking part in public performances, lessons, classes, sessions with industry professionals, and other events.

Through professional development and artistic training opportunities, including classes on diction, repertoire, style, working with conductors, new creation, entrepreneurship/media training, and performance psychology, pianists will gain all the tools and experience needed to lead a fulsome and rewarding career as a musical collaborator in opera.

RESPONSIBILITIES/EXPECTATIONS

- Work closely and under the supervision of the Head Coach and the Program Director
- Perform in concerts, masterclasses and events
- Participate in the preparation of singers on their roles and cover assignments
- Study and prepare full operas
- Play lessons and classes with guest and resident trainers
- Participate in staging rehearsals for ODM and Atelier lyrique productions as an assistant
